Being and lying in Long Hill Township, Surry County, North Carolina, adjoining the lands of Stone and lying off the old Hollow Road, bed six or seven hundred yards to the west and near the M. L. Patterson old residence, and being and containing one(1) acre, more or less, dedicated by the said M. L. Patterson and Davis as a family burial grounds, and being excepted in a deed from M. L. Patterson to Augustus Stone, and being surrounded by formerly Patterson, now Stone, lands.

It is expressly understood and agreed that the grantees herein shall hold the legal title to this property for the Patterson and Davis families for the purpose of a burial grounds, and that they or their survivors shall convey it to the next generation.
